P2023/24.65 BLOOR HOMES PRESENTATION

Cllrs received a presentation from Nick Rawlings of Bloor Homes, Guy Wakefield from Ridge and Partners and Robin Green from BWB the Bloor Homes' flooding consultants regarding proposals for an outline planning application for the first phase of development at the Hereford Southern Urban Expansion site allocation at Lower Bullingham as per Policy HD6 of the Herefordshire Local Plan – Core Strategy.

The presentation began by covering the original plan for the whole site which was predicated on the construction of the now abandoned Western Bypass, and how now, only part of that plan can be delivered without that infrastructure in place, which is described as phase one. 540 homes, a lot of green space, flood plains, a 'local' area and all employment land from original application.

Discussions focussed on flooding including how the plans have been written with and approved by the Environment Agency, testing to much higher levels than have ever naturally occurred therefore taking a precautionary view, the inclusion of basins to intercept, hold and release flood water and how the houses are protected from flooding due to the elevation of the two parcels of land containing houses. The main consideration for Cllrs was the impact of extra vehicular movement from the site during floods when the alternative access points are out of action, how emergency vehicles would access the site and how existing problems can be improved, not exacerbated.

Other discussions covered how the site addresses modal shift from car to alternative types of travel, ratios for primary and secondary school requirements and this development's impact on existing services including schools and medical services, the housing mix including less executive homes and more bungalows as well as affordable housing and climate measures including provision of EV charging, solar panels etc. Cllrs asked many questions over the proposal and expressed their concerns. Cllrs wanted to note their thanks to the presenters for providing answers to their questions.
